

What is SHIRP?

- FREE access to <u>electronic</u> resources for SK's healthcare practitioners
- Resources are a subset of USask Library's collection
- Funded by Government of SK
- Goal: All Saskatchewan healthcare practitioners have free access to the electronic resources they need.






How to access SHIRP

Any SK healthcare professional can make a SHIRP account and use our resources via our website.






How to access SHIRP
